- There are opportunities for JAM to use parent helpers.
 You can express your interest via an on-line form on the AMTC website. You will need to organise a VOLUNTEER WWCC (free) to help backstage.
- We realise that there will be times when people cannot attend rehearsals, but these should be kept to a minimum.
- We will ask you to UPDATE US about absences and new circumstances.
- To allow the creative team to make the best use of rehearsal time please arrive promptly.

- focus fully when at rehearsals
- stay inside the venue until signed out
- practice at home between JAM sessions with the music tracks
- make yourself available for all performances
